

Goal:

Students will improve their language proficiency through the functional use of French in authentic situations. Listening, speaking, reading and writing skills will be further enhanced, and active vocabulary will be expanded through readings and context based activities.

Essential Coursework:

A. Vocabulary to be covered will include an expansion of Level One and Two vocabulary and:

- Toiletries, Grooming, Daily Routines
- Describing People and Emotions
- Chores and Asking for Help
- The Environment
- Vacation and Describing Events
- Shopping and Expressions of Quantity
- Services
- Travel and Transportation

B. Grammar will include a review and expansion of Level One and Two concepts and:

- Reflexive Verbs: Present and Past and Idioms
- Subjunctive Forms and Use
- Use of Multiple Past Tenses in French (present perfect, imperfect simple past)
- Pronouns and Word Order
- Negative Expressions
- Future Tense
- Additional Exposure to Tenses (past perfect, future perfect, past conditional)
