## Calvert County Public Schools Quarantine Requirements for Students Effective 3/12/2021

### Requirements Due to Exposure

- A 10-day quarantine is required if someone is directly exposed and determined to be in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- The 10-day quarantine starts on the first day after the date of the exposure and ends on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine.
- This quarantine may be extended if symptoms occur during the 10 days.
- See exemption below for fully vaccinated students.

### Requirements with a Positive Test Result

- A 10-day quarantine is required if someone has tested positive for COVID-19.
- The 10-day quarantine starts on the first day after the date of the positive test for asymptomatic students or the day after the development of symptoms and ends on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine.

### Travel Related Quarantine Requirements

- A 10-day quarantine is required for anyone who travels outside of Maryland to a state that does not border Maryland between March 12, 2021 and April 11, 2021.
- The 10-day quarantine starts on the first day after return to the state and ends on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine.
- This is the only quarantine that can be reduced or eliminated if a negative COVID-19 test is obtained. (Rapid and PCR tests are accepted.)
- Fully vaccinated students are exempt from this requirement.

### Vaccination Exceptions to Quarantine Requirements

- Fully vaccinated students who are exposed are not required to quarantine.  
**Note:** Fully vaccinated students are students who have received the vaccine, and 14 days have passed since the date of the second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or one dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
- If a fully vaccinated student becomes symptomatic after an exposure, then the quarantine requirements will apply.
- This exception is good until the end of the 2020/2021 school year.

### Safety Protocols

- Fully vaccinated students are still required to follow all safety protocols.
- The 14-day quarantine due to Covid-19 exposure has been reduced to 10 days. (Any quarantine period that began prior to March 12, 2021, is not reduced.)
